

EASY SCARVES

Materials required: approximately 400m worsted weight yarn and 4.5 – 5.5 mm needles.

Cast on 28 stitches. Work in one of the following patterns (recommended as they lie flat) until scarf measures 48 inches or desired length. Cast off. Fringe is optional.

Garter Stitch: slip first stitch in each row, then knit all stitches in every row.

Seed Stitch:

Row 1: K1, P1 (rep across row)

Row 2: P1, K1 (rep across row)

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until scarf reaches desired length.

Rib Stitch:

Row 1 and every following row : K1, P1 (rep across row).

Double Moss Stitch:

Row 1: K2, P2 (rep across row)

Row 2: P2, K2 (rep across row)

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until scarf reaches desired length.

Basketweave:

Row 1: K4, P4 (rep across row)

Row 2: P4, K4 (rep across row)

Row 3: K4, P4 (rep across row)

Row 4: P4, K4 (rep across row)

Row 5: P4, K4 (rep across row)

Row 6: K4, P4 (rep across row)

Row 7: P4, K4 (rep across row)

Row 8: K4, P4 (rep across row)

Repeat Rows 1-8 until scarf reaches desired length.
