

Pattern 4: Crochet a Ribbon Necklace

This pattern may be made with a single strand of **Ladder Ribbon Maxi** or **East Track II**, or a combination of 2 ladder ribbons. A multitude of color combinations may be achieved by combining different colored ladder ribbons. Be adventurous and try out different color combinations. You will be pleasantly surprised at the outcome!



Finished length: Approx 24".

Materials: 1 ball of Berlini Ladder Ribbon Maxi or East Track II, 10.0 mm crochet hook if using the ribbon yarn single stranded; 12 mm crochet hook if double stranding your ribbon yarn.

Gauge: Not important

Notes:

- Length of necklace can be varied by increasing/decreasing the number of crochet stitches.
- Thickness of necklace can be varied by varying the number of strands held together.
- Make 4-5 strands if using East Track II or Ladder Ribbon Maxi as a single strand, make 3 strands if combining 2 ladder ribbons (holding them together)
- 1 ball of yarn makes approx 6 necklaces based on patterns given below.

Directions:

Using one or two strands of the ribbon yarns held together, Ch 42 (this makes a length of approx. 24"). Slip stitch in first stitch to form a loop/circle. This forms the first loop/circle strand.

Ch 44 for 2nd strand. To make the 2nd loop/circle strand, slip stitch through first stitches of BOTH first and second strands.

Ch 46 for 3rd strand. To make the 3rd loop/circle strand, slip stitch through first stitches of all 3 strands.

For each additional strand, continue as above – increasing the number of chains by two for each additional strand.

Bind off. Weave in all ends.
